Dear Ombudsman and Kelly Kritsch,

This document was sent to Me in another email thread by Kelly Kritsch - so at least My suspicions regarding the sender of the package are correct. My memory is not perfect and I had said to the Ombudsman that I believed the address was Writ in cursive, properly addressed to 'King Sean, House von Dehn', and I thought I had remembered a large *brown* envelope - it may have been white, I'm not sure. But the attachment does show what I remembered the sticker on the package to look like. I was absolutely certain it was hand writ.

But I Wish for the Ombudsman to take Notice that ***the date of acceptance at the top right of the form has been altered.*** I'm curious to know who altered the date to a hand Writ 'May 23'? It's still clear enough to see that the original stamp had been dated May '24'. Why is the date altered?

This email has also been sent to Kelly Kritsch and the City of Ottawa's lawyer, Genevieve Langlais.

I'm still curious to know why the receipt from Canada Post says the package was delivered to Me, not *returned to sender*?

Does the attached receipt match the receipt that Canada Post has on file for this Matter? Can I get a copy of Canada Post's version of this receipt, and can some One tell Me who authorized the change? If the date was altered after the document was stamped, there should at least be a Signature or initials to Show that it was an authorized representative of Canada Post that altered the date of acceptance.
